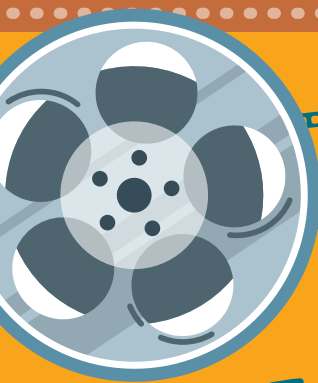

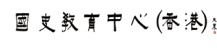

## Regulations

1. All entries must be recommended and submitted by schools. Individual submission by students is not allowed.
2. There is no limit in the number of participants in each school. Teachers must choose the best 10 entries in each division for submission.
3. Each participant shall submit one entry only.
4. Participants may choose any books for the Extensive Reading English Section.

## Awards

There will be a champion, a 1st runner-up, a 2nd runner-up and 8 merits in each division.

Champion	HK\$1,500 book coupon, certificate and prizes
1 <sup>st</sup> Runner-up	HK\$1,000 book coupon, certificate and prizes
2 <sup>nd</sup> Runner-up	HK\$700 book coupon, certificate and prizes
Merits	HK\$300 book coupon, certificate and prizes

## Format of Entries

- ⦿ Please write down student's name, class and class number in the entry.
- ⦿ Please list the book title, author, and publisher in the entry.
- ⦿ The word limits for the Junior Division is between 600 and 800 words, and the Senior Division is between 800 and 1,200 words, including punctuation.
- ⦿ Handwritten or typewritten entries on standard A4 size paper are acceptable, paper with school letterhead or badge is not allowed.
- ⦿ Entries should be legible and tidy. The number of pages and the total number of words must be specified.
