- Each participant shall submit one entry only.
- Participants may choose any books for the Extensive English Reading Section.



Awards

There will be a champion, a 1st runner-up, a 2nd runner-up, 3 outstanding and 3 commendable awards.

- Entries are required to be handwritten or typed on standard A4 paper. Paper including the school letterhead or emblem will not be accepted.
- ➤ Entries should be legible and tidy. The number of pages and the total number of words must be specified. Please submit the entries in Word Document / PDF format.

Adjudication Guidelines

- **▶** The adjudication of the competition is divided into 3 stages:
 - Stage 1 In-school adjudication by school teachers
 - Each school teacher-in-charge will choose the best 10 entries in each division for submission.
 - Stage 2 Preliminary adjudication by initial jurors
 - All jurors are senior secondary school teachers. Each juror will select outstanding entries and then pass them to professional jurors to complete final adjudication.
 - **Stage 3** Final adjudication by professional jurors
 - The jury is formed by university professor, lecturer and advisors. All jurors have abundant teaching experience in secondary schools.
- **▶** Works will be mainly judged by students' understanding of the book and their personal comments.
- Adjudication criteria:
 - Content (40%) Entry is rich in content and themes are described clearly; express deep understanding through evaluating the text from different angles.
 - Organization (40%) Clear introduction and background; Text is organized very effectively with logical development of ideas.
 - Language (20%) Wide range of accurate sentence structures, with good grasp of complex sentences.






